

PUTTING THE HEART BACK INTO M RTLAKE

Do you care what happens to the future of the Brewery Site in Mortlake?

The site was sold in November 2015. There will be an open exhibition in the brewery building from 1 - 4 March (to be confirmed shortly) where the developers will reveal their proposals. Full planning applications will be made later in 2017.

But you don't have to wait till the exhibition or the planning applications to let Richmond Council and your local Councillors know what you think and feel about the Brewery Site.

Take the opportunity to influence the changes you want to see and add your comments to the new Local Plan for the Borough

The Council is currently consulting on the final version of the Local Plan for the whole borough. The deadline for comments is 15 February.

The section on Mortlake states the Council's preferences for the Brewery Site.

The facts

In 2011, based on two years' consultation with the people of Mortlake, Sheen and Barnes, the Council adopted a detailed planning brief for the Brewery Site including preservation of the green playing field. This brief had huge support from the local community.

Now in 2017, the Council say they continue to support that planning brief, but the original proposal for a primary school has been changed to one for a large secondary school.

There is now a big risk that the emerging demands from both the developers and the Council for the site will mean building on the Green Playing Field and creating a dense development. The result could be a school squashed onto a potentially crowded site.

If the site is overdeveloped this will increase traffic and air pollution.

Building on the Green Playing Field will halve the green open space in Mortlake.
